ORDER

Facts:

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 19.03.2015 seeking copy of deliberations and documents including notings by all officers who dealt with the matters showing reasons for such a decision and assigning construction works in the President Estate including construction of museum to PSU M/S NBCC Ltd. without tender process on nomination basis.
2. The CPIO responded on 16.04.2015. The appellant filed first appeal on 20.04.2015 with the First Appellate Authority (FAA). The FAA responded on 30.05.2015. The appellant filed second appeal on 20.06.2016 before the Commission with the plea that the sought for information has not been provided to him.

Hearing:

3. The appellant and the respondent both participated in the hearing personally.
4. The appellant stated that some construction work in the President Estate including construction of a museum were taken from CPWD by the President Secretariat and assigned to a PSU M/s NBCC Ltd on nomination

basis. The appellant stated that he has received the information sought for by him. The appellant stated that he has not been provided information 1) Interest received by President Secretariat on advance amount paid to M/s NBCC, 2) File notings and documents of President Secretariat office while taking decision to award the work to M/s NBCC. The appellant stated that the respondent be directed to provide the aforesaid information to him.

5. The respondent stated that they have replied to the RTI application on 16.04.2015. The respondent stated that the first appellate authority vide its order dated 30.05.2015 had disposed of the first appeal having concurred with the findings of the CPIO.

Discussion/ observation:

6. The aforesaid information can be provided to the appellant and the respondent has no objection in providing such information.

Decision:

7. Respondent is directed to provide information, as mention in para 4 above, to the appellant within 30 days of this order.

The appeal is disposed of. A copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
