**ORDER**

**Facts:**

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 16.01.2015 seeking information regarding process for vetting of 'dues amount' and process for dues payment of the employee in the new zone when he is released as per inter Zonal mutual Transfer etc.
2. The CPIO responded on 04.02.2015, 10.02.2015, 13.02.2015, 16.02.2015. The appellant filed first appeal on 13.03.2015 with the First Appellate Authority (FAA). The FAA responded on 09.04.2015. The appellant filed second appeal on 23.06.2015 before the Commission with the plea that the sought for information has not been provided to him.

**Hearing:**

3. The appellant and the respondent both participated in the hearing.
4. The appellant stated that he has been transferred on mutual transfer. The appellant stated that he has not been paid: 1) arrears as per 6<sup>th</sup> CPC 2) PLB arrears of 2007-2008 3) KMA during the period 08.01.2008 to 31.01.2008. The appellant stated that he has not been provided any information.
5. The respondent stated that they do not have the service record of the appellant. The respondent stated that on transfer of employee to another

division the pay particulars and service record are verified by accounts and sent to personnel branch for onward submission to another division. The respondent stated that his LPC (Las Pay Certificate) has been sent to the concerned Office. The appellant stated that on mutual transfer employee's division is changed and as such his records have been transferred to Adra Division SER Railway. The respondent stated that all dues will be paid by Aadra Division. The respondent stated that the appellant vide letter dated 04.02.2015 has been replied pointwise and a copy of his LPC has been provided to him. The respondent stated that all payments and dues are mentioned in the LPC.

6. The appellant stated that all dues have not been mentioned in his LPC and he is not satisfied. The appellant stated that he has not been paid bonus for 10 months.

**Discussion/ observation:**

7. The action/steps taken by the respondent in dealing with the RTI application is satisfactory. However, if the information concerned the Adra division, the RTI should have been transferred to Adra Division.

8. The RTI application may be sent along with this order and may be considered as transferred RTI application.

**Decision:**

9. The Sr. DEE/RSO Adra Division SER Railway is directed to look into matter and provide the information to the appellant within 30 days of this order. The copy of the RTI application and LPC is enclosed with this order for necessary action.

The appeal is disposed of. A copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
