ORDER

Facts:

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 07.07.2015, seeking travel details of passenger named Mr. D.K Vij having PNR No. 2634180423 who travelled by Amritsar Shatabdi on 24.04.2010 from Jalandhar city to New Delhi and whether Shri D.K Vij came back from New Delhi to Jalandhar city and the PNR No, coach no, seat no etc for this return journey.
2. The CPIO responded on 17.07.2015. The appellant filed First Appeal dated nil, with First Appellate Authority (FAA). The FAA responded dated 01.09.2015. The appellant filed second appeal on 16.09.2015 before the Commission on the ground that information should be provided to him.

Hearing:

3. The appellant and the respondent participated in the hearing.
4. The appellant stated that the sought for information has not been provided to him. The appellant stated that he is seeking information related to his own PNR number. The appellant stated that the sought for information does not pertain to third party.

5. The respondent stated that the appellant has been replied to vide letter dated 17.07.2015. The respondent stated that the booked tickets are property of user Id holder ie. the one who books the ticket by using his user Id and Password. The respondent stated that in the instant case Mr. Kanpreet had booked tickets with his user Id and password. The respondent stated that they had emailed to him on receiving the a RTI application seeking similar information by Mr. Chugh Vide reply dated 27.06.2015, the registered user had denied permission to give the sought for information. The respondent stated that third party information cannot be provided without consent of the third party.

Discussion/ observation:

6. The fresh comments from Mr. Kanpreet who booked the ticket, should have been called for by the respondent as in this case, the applicant was different, namely Mr. D.K Vij.

Decision:

7. The respondent is directed to follow the process of section 11 of the RTI Act afresh and provide information to the appellant as per the RTI Act, free of cost within 30 days of this order.

The appeal is disposed of. Copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
